NOTICE OF PROPOSED NEW REGULATION

DATE: May 26, 2006

REGULATION CHAPTER TITLE: Student Affairs

REGULATION TITLE AND NUMBER: Popular Concerts and Activities (2.025)

SUMMARY OF REGULATION: The amended Regulation deletes obsolete language, clarifies existing language and provides that promoters of fund-raising popular concerts must present evidence of a \$1 million general liability policy, listing Florida A&M University, its Board of Trustees, Florida Board of Governors and the State of Florida as additional insured. The University may also require the promoter to post a bond to guarantee funds due to the University.

AUTHORITY FOR REGULATION: Article IX, Florida Constitution, Board of Governors Regulation Development Procedure dated July 21, 2005 and Section 1001.74(10), Florida Statutes.
